GENERAL PROGRAM INFORMATION

Alberta Summer Games (Inline)

The first stage in the Hockey Alberta Inline Team Alberta program for athletes, coaches, trainers and administrators is the Alberta Summer Games. This event is held in even years. Players are selected to compete in the Alberta Summer Games based on their performance at a zone identification camp. 8 Zone camps will be held, one for each of the Alberta Games Zones. From these selection camps 8 teams will be formed to compete in the Alberta Summer Games.

2010 Alberta Summer Games (Teams are athletes born 1995, 1996, 1997)

- m We are looking for one trainer to head up the Safety Program for each Zone Team through the selection camp and competition.
- m Applicants should be training at a fairly competitive level with a minimum of Hockey Canada Safety Program and First Aid / CPR certifications.

THE PROCESS

- m Applications must be received into the Hockey Alberta Office.
- m Applicants may be sent a Post Task once their application has been received.
- m Applicants will be selected & notified by the Hockey Alberta Selection Committee.

a) Professional Development

- m Qualifications and certification attained –
 - o CPR/First Aid – *mandatory*
 - o Hockey Canada Safety Program - *recommended*
 - o Other assets: *Sport First Responder, CATA Certification, Certificate or Diploma in Sport Physiotherapy, Certification Candidate in CATA or Sport Physiotherapy, SMCA Athletic First Aid, SMCA Sports Taping*
- m Attendance and participation at related seminars
- m Education
- m Memberships and affiliations

b) Experience

- m Years of experience in your selected field
- m Scope of experience (teams, responsibilities, events, tournament play)
- m Years of experience with this level of athlete
- m Previous zone or provincial experience

c) Human Resources

- m Proven ability to take initiative and efficiently use time
- m Proven ability to work with other staff
- m Proven ability to successfully relate to and work with players at this age level
- m Proven ability to successfully cope with deterrents and hardships in a pressure situation
- m Proven ability to be thoroughly organized

d) Knowledge of Program

- m Proven ability to work towards objectives of a program
- m Proven appreciation for and awareness of the unique problems that can conceivably occur in the operation of a zone team
